INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE PETE THE PURPLE BULL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS

General Information

The PPB Scholarship is limited to graduating high school seniors who must meet these two criteria:

1) Have graduated from one of these Iowa or Illinois Quad City high schools listed below:

- Davenport Mid City
- Davenport North
- Davenport West
- Rocky High School
- Moline High School
- United Township High School

2) Are attending one of the following colleges:

- BLACK HAWK COLLEGE
- SCOTT COMMUNITY COLLEGE
- ST. AMBROSE UNIVERSITY

The total number of recipients and the scholarship amount is determined annually, by the PPB Board of Directors and is contingent upon the funds raised at the annual “Swing into Education” Scholarship Golf Tournament. This year’s tournament will be held June 18th, 2021 at Duck Creek Golf Course in Davenport, Iowa.

Scholarship applicants must also adhere to the following guidelines and format:

- 1) Maintain a 2.5 cumulative grade point average, or equivalent, on a 4-point scale.
- 2) Submit ACT or SAT composite score (only if attending ST. AMBROSE UNIVERSITY)
- 3) Attach copy of transcript
- 4) Complete the following:
 - a) Application Face Sheet
 - b) Objective Criteria Page *Must include recommendation from a school representative (counselor, teacher or administrator)
 - c) The Awards and Activities Page (this information may also be typed and attached)
 - d) **Essay** (please attach a one page typed essay (minimum of 300 words) which includes the following:
 - Your future career goals and why
 - Who and/or what experiences have influenced you
 - How will you contribute to your community?
- 5) **ALL APPLICATIONS must be submitted by April 23RD, 2021**

Evaluation Procedure

The Scholarship Committee will use the following criteria when determining QC United Scholarship Awards:

- I. 25% Academic standing (ACT or SAT score if applicable & GPA)
- II. 25% Financial Need
- III. 30% Extracurricular activities (based on school and/or work experiences)
- IV. 20% Community Service/Volunteerism

Upon completion of the evaluation process, applicants will be notified of the results.
